LEAGUE PLAY

High probability of additional tournament play in Sep/Oct/Nov.

8 Family volunteer hours - per player in club - during North v South tournament, Aug 7th-8th. This tournament is SLOSC's main fundraiser.

AYSO INVOLVEMENT

- AYSO league participation is permitted, but club league and/or tournament schedule has priority over AYSO league schedule.
- Based on some of the players transitioning into high school in November, SLOSC recommends AYSO All-Star participation for the remaining players. The reason for this is that participation in any state or national cups would be limited to Spring and Summer.
